

# Conversation Trust Funds as Boosters for Nature Based Solutions: A Case Study of the Legacy Landscapes Fund

Climate change and biodiversity loss cannot be seen separately anymore and exacerbate each other in speed, impact and consequences. Global leaders are pledging more funding and public and private funders are creating strong coalitions to address the climate-biodiversity nexus. But the current reality of public funding is not sufficient in terms of volume, with funding sources remaining in silos and being based on separated budgets for climate or biodiversity.

Conservation trust funds (CTF) are one vehicle to strongly boost the application of nature-based solutions globally. CTF like the Legacy Landscapes Fund merge and leverage different funding sources for immediate impact. This discussion between two IDFC members who are contributing to the LLF will highlight the rationale of using CTFs as climate funding instrument. It will also demonstrate that the LLF is an efficient and effective way to get closer to the international climate financing goals.
