Description of objective, content and expected outcomes of the session	<p>Objective: Firms in developing countries are increasingly implementing decarbonization plans. The session presents the main challenges and opportunities that hard-to-abate sectors have been facing in developing countries and their project pipelines. It allows IDFC members and stakeholders to learn from the experience of firms as well as academia to discuss funding solutions and innovative solutions to unlock Paris-aligned finance.</p> <p>Content: The session will be based on one academic policy-oriented presentation from AFD team on the main risks and opportunities developing countries are facing given the transition. The presentation will be followed by case studies. Development banks and policy makers will present their transition plans, main funding challenges, and the main technological or nature-based solutions.
